Ferrets make wonderful pets and are fun additions to any family. However, their anatomy and physiology make them unique in many ways. This makes their medical and surgical care a special challenge. For this reason, it is important to have your pet examined by a veterinarian at least once a year. Additionally, because illness is often masked in these species, routine laboratory tests are highly recommended on an annual basis. Basic screening provides especially useful information when first obtaining your ferret from a breeder or pet store.
